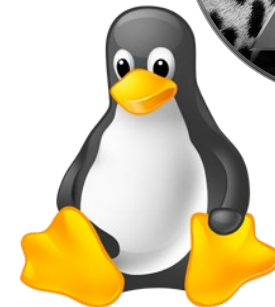

You can join us too. At the beginning of the fall semester at the kick off meeting, members can volunteer for officer positions. Ask any officer how you can become an officer too!

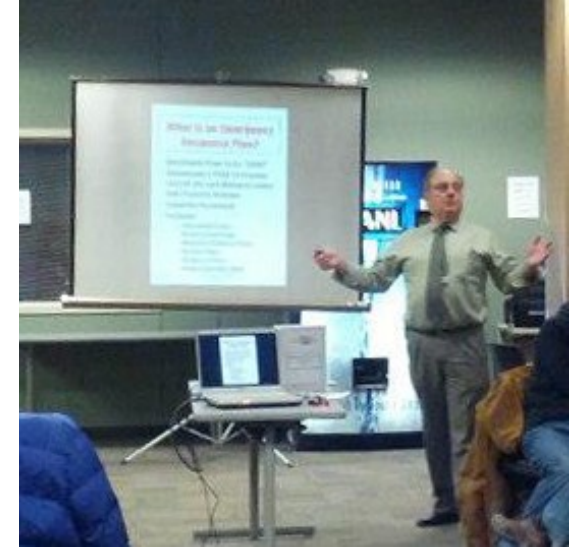
